

TLAS provides a vast range of services that include the information, awareness, advice and legal representation of the people in need:

Paralegal services (solution of legal cases through administrative way);

Legal services (solution of legal cases through court procedures);

Law-line service (legal advice through telephone line);

Clinics (enable clients for self-representation before state authorities);

Mediation (alternative dispute resolution);

Mobile service (to reach vulnerable individuals in remote area with resources).



The demands of the vulnerable categories for legal aid are growing
















TLAS NUMBER OF CASES BY TYPE January 1, 2009 - November 2009



TLAS attorneys represent in courts an average of 350 cases per year






- * TLAS expert provides legal advice through the phone.

TLAS attorneys provide legal services in field, in rural areas for the clients with limited possibilities













Raising the awareness of the vulnerable communities and publication of information on important legal and human right issues are one of the main objectives of TLAS.

"Street Law" activities (Publication, information, education and legal awareness of the community) TLAS organizes visits and meetings through street law activities in the urban and rural areas of the various districts and publishes various legal publications for such activities written in a simple language for public use.

Students from the Faculty of Justice and Social Work, involved in the Internship Programme are present in TLAS offices, involved in information and awareness activities of street law, in mobile services and in assisting the clients' case management as well as other specific activities.

Enhancement of the legal capacities of NPO's, representatives of the TLAS target groups. This includes the registration in court of local associations; training workshops for the strengthening of their legal capacities; training workshops for the state structures employees; training workshops for the court administration employees and judges.

TLAS Internship Programme



The Group of Experts hired by TLAS was included in the legal initiative for the amendment of the Law no. 7698, dated 15. 04. 1993 "For the restitution and compensation of the properties to former owners". The results were reflected in the law adopted in July 2004





The TLAS Group of Experts drafted the law "On Legal Aid", adopted by the Albanian Assembly in 22 December 2008



TLAS prepared the amendments of the existing legal framework on the activity of court staff (AACS) drafting of legal and sub-legal acts on court staff activity, in 2004.

TLAS is involved in the preparation of sub-legal acts on legal practice in Albania for the inclusion of legal aid attorneys in the higher category of attorneys.

TLAS supported the invalids of military services to be included and benefit by the legislation on invalids.

TLAS supported and presented the ex-prosecuted for ordinary crimes (EPOC), to benefit by the legislation for the working years during the prison.




TLAS finalised on November 2009 the Study Report for improvement of the Social Welfare Benefit Legislation and some important conclusions and recomandations
